

## Business Bankruptcy Book to be Released by Noted Bankruptcy Attorney this Fall

COLORADO PUBLISHER SIGNS DEAL WITH NOTED BANKRUPTCY ATTORNEY FOR FALL RELEASE OF BUSINESS BANKRUPTCY BOOK

Parker, Colorado, June 22, 2006. Outskirts Press and Alderman & Alderman announced today that noted bankruptcy attorney Myles H. Alderman, Jr. has signed a contract to allow Outskirts Press, of Parker Colorado to publish his new book on business reorganizations under Chapter 11 of the United States Bankruptcy Code.

The book, scheduled for release this fall, will offer insights into bankruptcy law issues that can affect anyone who extends credit to, or has contracts with, businesses with operations in the United States: Insights that normally are only available to Mr. Alderman's clients or those who have attended a number of his seminars. Since that time, Mr. Alderman has repeatedly been called upon to share his insights about the United States Bankruptcy system with practicing attorneys and business leaders. Readers may have heard some of his bankruptcy comments on radio interviews or read them in such widely read publications as the New York Times.
